

CGCA Show Awards and New Category Descriptions

Awards and Prizes:

Best Of Show: Highest scoring display of all displays. (Award \$2000.00)

Best Educational Display: This award based on the highest points from the general educational value from the judging form. In the event of two displays having the same amount of points the one with the highest overall score will be selected. The best of Show is not eligible for this award. (Award \$1000.00)

Best of Category Awards: For the top scoring display in each of the nine show categories that did not win one of the above prizes. (Award \$1000 each).

Ten Displays of Merit: The next ten highest scoring displays that did not win one of the above prizes. This is not category dependent. (Award \$150 Each)

New Show Categories:

Best Antique Rifles: Pre 1899. The displays should have a theme that educates others about the history, the development and importance of the weapons in the display.

Best Classic Rifles: 1899 and after. The displays should have a theme that educates others about the history, the development and importance of the weapons in the display.

Best Antique Handguns: Pre 1899. The displays should have a theme that educates others about the history, the development and importance of the weapons in the display.

Best Classic Handguns: 1899 and after. The displays should have a theme that educates others about the history, the development and importance of the weapons in the display.

Best Antique Military: Pre 1899. Weapons and Arms used primarily by the militaries of the world. The displays should have a theme that educates others about the history, development and importance of the weapons in the display.

Best Classic Military: 1899 and after. Weapons and Arms used primarily by the

militaries of the world. The displays should have a theme that educates others about the history, development and importance of the weapons in the display.

Best Shot gun Display: The displays should have a theme that educates others about the history, development and importance of the weapons in the display.

Best Single Gun or Related Pair: A single gun and/or pair of some importance such as one of kind, belonging or having belonged to some one of importance, exceptional engraving or decorations, or of historical importance.

Best Non-Gun Related Display: Knives, Swords, Western memorabilia and other gun related curios.

Additional Information:

All categories' will be scored by independent judges. The criteria are the same as before with one exception, there is now an additional criteria for educational value. A display may win only one award.

All displays will be placed in the category as declared by the displayer. Displays that cross over into two or more categories will be placed in the category declared by the displayers.

If a display is placed into a category that it obviously does not belong in, i.e.: a rifle display in the shotgun category, then the CGCA awards committee will have final say as to which category the display is assigned.

All other display rules of past CGCA shows still apply.
