I agree to indemnify and hold harmless from any action the CGCA, the IGRP/Greeley, and/or their members, subcontractors, representatives and agents. I have read and understand the show rules and that my failure to comply may result in expulsion from the show.

It is mandatory that all firearms be Antique or Curio & Relic, unloaded and all cartridge firearms must be safety tied or inoperable.

CGCA Show Rules

I. GENERAL:

1. All transactions involving the purchase, sale, or trade of firearms and other items at the show must comply with all applicable Federal, State and local laws, including State and local Sales Tax. **All individuals are solely responsible for ensuring the compliance of their own items.**
2. TABLES:
 - a. Tables may not be moved or relocated without written permission. Nothing shall protrude past a table's edge into the aisle.
 - b. Space behind tables shall be maintained so that other exhibitors will have safe access to their tables and egress.
 - c. Tables may not be transferred between exhibitors without specific written permission of the CGCA Show Chairman.
 - d. Tables not occupied by 5pm Friday will be forfeited without reimbursement.
 - e. Tables vacated prior to the conclusion of the show will revert to the CGCA.
 - f. All exhibit & trade tables will be uncovered and maintained during show hours. Tables shall not be left unattended or unsecured during the show. If your tables are found unattended before 3pm on Sunday you will lose your table location preference.
 - g. Table covers are mandatory on all tables and the use of the United States flag as a table cover is prohibited.
3. Release stickers will be provided to the table holders for the table holder to place on all firearms and related items sold.
4. Exhibitor badges: The exhibitor is responsible for all badges, tables and displays in his/her name.
5. There will be no refunds for cancellations received less than 30 days prior to the show's start.
6. Items which are components of a competitive display may not be sold, traded or otherwise disposed of during the show.
7. Should any problem occur it must be immediately reported to the CGCA show staff.

II. SAFETY

1. NO LOADED GUNS!
2. Firearms may not be worn except by uniformed law enforcement officers and show security personnel.
3. All firearms must be unloaded and all cartridge firearms safety tied; this includes those in locked display cases.
4. Drug and/or alcohol consumption of any kind is prohibited on the premises; Anyone under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol is prohibited from handling any firearms, and may be removed at the discretion of security.
5. The CGCA Safety Committee will strictly enforce safety rules and the decisions of the committee are final.

III. PERMITTED ITEMS:

1. Antique or Curio and Relic (C&R) firearms, as defined by ATF rules; Antique firearms are considered any manufactured in or before 1898, or replicas of these that do not fire standard rimfire or centerfire ammunition. Curio and Relic firearms are considered to be those manufactured 50 years or more before the current date, or those certified by a museum curator to possess inherent historic value.
2. Collectable, historic, rare, or military surplus ammunition for small arms, and inert collectable ordnance; Ammunition must be safely stored in boxes or containers, while single cartridges of a collectible nature may be displayed in a case only accessible to the vendor.
3. Collectable accessories and attachments for permitted small arms, including sighting, carrying and cleaning equipment, supplies and accessory belts of antique nature
4. Parts for collectable arms as defined by the ATF rules for Antique and C&R, including material for making such parts
5. Non-firing replicas, if of a high quality and based on and true to an original antique or C&R firearm
6. Historic militaria, including helmets and headwear, uniform items, patches and medals, field gear, historic military vehicle parts, and related collectable military items; Items must be of 20th century or older manufacture, or historically accurate modern reproductions.
7. Antique weapons and collectable items including edged weapons, armor, bows, crossbows, arrows, etc.
8. Books and literature related to allowed materials
9. Western art which is defined as authentic, original art of Western American subject matter, both sculpture and graphic art; Collectable frontier and Native American paraphernalia, such as original, authentic weapons, accoutrements, paraphernalia made for use on the western frontier, and historic Native American artifacts are permitted, but not general antiques.
10. Any other articles or devices that can be properly related to the mission and activities of the CGCA

IV. PROHIBITED ITEMS:

1. Firearms or receivers of newer manufacture than C&R, or otherwise not classifiable as antique or C&R, as defined by the ATF; Antique replicas modified to fire modern ammunition, or military C&R firearms no longer in their original military configuration (including semi-auto conversions), are not permitted for sale or trade.
2. C&R weapons which are still subject to the provisions of the National Firearms Act (see Section IV of ATF Curios or Relics List), may not be sold or traded. This includes fully-automatic weapons and artillery, even if DEWAT/demilled, blank-fire only non-guns (BFONG), and NFA parts kits, even if classified as C&R.
3. Modern, widely available ammunition, gunpowder, Pyrodex, live explosive ordnance, and loose ammunition
4. Modern blades; time-pieces; gems & minerals; stamps; coins & currency; furniture; glassware; modern hunting, fishing, & sporting; modern scopes; modern reloading tools; leather and leatherworking tools; unrelated toys & games; modern Native American artifacts; jewelry; scrimshaw; antique machinery & tools not related to guns & ammo; clothing, except militaria; any other unrelated antiques
5. Art, except for Western art as defined above in permitted items

CGCA reserves the right to request the removal of any item(s) deemed objectionable to the mission of the association and the integrity of the show. Refusal to comply may result in expulsion.

In order to maintain the show's high standards, all items on trade or display tables must be considered collectable as determined by the CGCA Quality Control Committee, and as outlined above. Should a question or concern arise regarding an item, the Quality Control Committee will be the final authority on permitted and prohibited items.
